RHTP Statement on Dr. George Tiller

Washington, D.C. – The Reproductive Health Technologies Project (RHTP) joins our colleagues in sending condolences to Dr. George Tiller’s family, his clinic staff, and all of those whose lives have been touched by his work. The murder of Dr. Tiller is a devastating loss for our community and for the women who so profoundly need his services.

Statement by Jenn Rogers, Acting Executive Director, RHTP:

“In this time of sorrow, let us not be immobilized by our sadness, but rather be inspired by the example of Dr. Tiller. Every time Dr. Tiller was personally harassed or injured, or when his clinic was violated, he bravely continued to practice his commitment to providing safe and legal abortion services to women in need. Today, RHTP will remember Dr. Tiller by following his example: carrying on our work to ensure the best quality reproductive health services are available to every woman, based on her needs and unique circumstances. We strengthen our resolve to create a society that will support and respect a woman and her family as they face the life-altering decision of whether or not to continue a pregnancy.”
